

Beautiful Beaches

Bang Saen Beach

Bang Saen is one of the most famous and popular attractions near the city, so on every holiday the beach will be crowded with tourists, especially Thai families. The beach stretches approximately 2.5 kilometers long, and is lively with colorful beach umbrellas, sun beds, and banana boats under rows of coconut trees. The sandy beach is clean. Yet the gradual slope makes it a nice and safe spot for swimming.

Jomtien Beach

Jomtien beach is located about two kilometers south of Pattaya. The beach is perfect for those who wish to find their quiet corner under the shade of an umbrella. Its sandy beach is fringed with pine trees, quite narrow and has a small slope into the sea.

Pattaya beach

Pattaya beach is a half-moon-shaped beach about four kilometers long with Beach Road running parallel to the beach. It is one of the best-known beaches of Thailand. Its fame comes from the beauty of nature, full facilities and services for tourists, and fun from all kinds of sea activities.

Hat Toei Ngam

Hat Toei Ngam has lines of toei trees on the 200 meters crescent beach. It is one of most beautiful beach in Sattahip.

Hat Nang Ram

Hat Nang Ram is a 200 meters long beach. At the tip of the beach stands the shrine of Kromluang Chumphonkhetudomsak, the Father of Royal Thai Navy.

Hat Nang Rong

Hat Nang Rong is a short distance beyond Hat Nang Ram. It is a 200 meter beach with pine trees.

Hat Thian Tale

Hat Thian Tale is a sandy beach alternating with rocks, covering an area of 900 meters. It is a panoramic sightseeing point, with a bizarre shape of cliffs with a view of the sunset.

Hat Tham Khao Phang

Hat Tham Khao Phang at the back of the island surrounds this white sandy beach. The sloping beach is thus on the sheltered side.

Hat Wong Phra Chan

Hat Wong Phra Chan is a small tranquil one kilometer beach, on the northern side of Pattaya Bay.

Koh Si Chang

Most areas of Koh Si Chang are high hills, pine trees, and sandy beaches. It has no streams or rivers to produce freshwater at all. Thus Koh Si Chang islands all recognize the value of freshwater.

Koh Kang Kao

Koh Kang Kao is a small island located in the southeast of Koh Si Chang. It is a very quiet island. The beaches of this island are clean and nice for swimming, with some coral reefs for diving too.

Koh Lan

Koh Lan is an island 7.5 kilometers from South Pattaya. It has six main beaches. All of the beaches are of white sand and clear azure waters.

Koh Sak

Six hundred meters north of Koh Lan is Koh Sak, a small island shaped like an upturned horseshoe. There are two connecting beaches to the north and south.

Koh Kham

Koh Kham is a small island located around 20 minutes away from Sattahip district. The island with an H shape has a sand bar in the middle, and the beaches at two opposite sides. It has abundant coral reefs and smooth stony.

The beach of Koh Kham is a white fine sandy one, stretching for approximately 500 meters long. The gradual slope makes it a nice spot for swimming and relaxing. Most of all, it is also the place where ones could find marvelous marine world.
